There is a lot of involvement in the bird population. With the draught, the mosquito that would have been biting people weren't around but the ones that bite the bird population were. It is the Culex Mosquito are the ones responsible spreading this virus through the bird population. That is where they have been nipping a little at a time, by being invited into peoples yards and pointing out the good and bad things that they are doing in their own yard. We tried to track down where these mosquitoes were coming from. We have tested 350 pools and about 80 of them show the tiger mosquito.
